Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of Sail Canada that apply will be posted on the notice board.
- 1.3 Rule 64.1 will be amended in the Sailing Instructions to specify penalties other than disqualification for infringement of class rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International 6 Metre class.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at the event website www.royalvan.com/oceana before midnight on Wednesday, May 15.
- 2.3 Late registration is permitted until 1000 hours on Saturday, May 18 and is subject to an additional fee.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are \$195 payable in Canadian dollars and include a hosted cocktail party on Sunday evening.
- 3.2 The late registration additional fee is \$50.
- 3.3 Fees do not include lunches.

4 SCHEDULE

Saturday, May 18: First scheduled warning signal at 1100 hours. Four races are scheduled.

Sunday, May 19: First scheduled warning signal at 1100 hours. Three races are scheduled. No warning signal will be displayed after 1500 hours.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the event web site at noon on Friday, May 17 and will be posted on the notice board.

6 VENUE & MOORAGE

Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and the racing area.

7 THE COURSES

- 7.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward leeward courses
- 7.2 Target times will be 50 minutes.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.2 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with flags provided by the organizing authority and shall carry VHF radios.

10 BERTHING

All boats shall be kept in their assigned places.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

11.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

11.2 It is recommended that boats carry a VHF radio for safety and race operations. The race committee will attempt to broadcast details of upcoming starts, recalls and starting penalties.

12 MEDIA RIGHTS.

By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any still or motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1 million per event or the equivalent.
