2 FLAG POLE & OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

The flag pole is on the north side of the main clubhouse, The official notice board is online at the event website http://www.royalvan.com/SPLASH.

3 THE COURSES

Courses and marks are shown in Addendum A.

4. THE START

To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the race committee may make a series of short sound signals. This changes Appendix S.

5 CLASS FLAGS

Class flags are the class insignia on a plain background, except

ILCA 6 Class insignia on a red background ILCA 4 Class insignia on a yellow background

Optimist Green Green flag with no insignia

6 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark or the finishing line to a new position. This changes Appendix S.

7 TIME LIMITS


- 7.2 Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window, and not subsequently retiring, penalized or given redress, will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing. A boat scored TLE shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within the Finishing Window. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10.
- 8 AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS
- 8.1 A line beginning at the northwest corner of the Royal Vancouver YC Jericho breakwater, through a series of orange and white can buoys ending with the north end of the most westerly pier at Jericho Sailing Centre, delimits an obstruction. Boats may not pass south of this line.
- 8.2 Boats may not enter City of Vancouver swim areas off Jericho Beach, Kitsilano and Spanish Banks. These are designated as an obstruction.
- 9 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS (CHANGES TO APPENDIX S)
- 9.1 The protest time limit is 45 minutes after the race committee signal boat returns to the harbour.
- 9.2 Hearing request forms are available using the Protest link on the event web site.
- 9.3 Scoring inquiries and questions around finishing order and missing sail numbers may be sent to racecommittee@rvan.ca.
- 9.4 Notices will be posted on the electronic notice board on the event website no later than 15 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.
- 9.5 A list of boats that have been penalized for breaking RRS 42 under Appendix P will be posted on the official notice board.
- SCORING
 RRS A2.1 is changed so that a boat must complete five races before her worst score is excluded.
- 11 SAFETY REGULATIONS
- 11.1 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.
- 11.2 [DP] Boats shall not obstruct commercial traffic and must obey all warning signals and directions from commercial and race committee vessels.
- 12 RADIO COMMUNICATION


