

2024 Canadian Intercollegiate Sailing Association Keelboat Match Racing National Championship

Sunday Runner-up Fleet Race Series

As allowed under NOR section 11, the Event Format for Sunday February 25th may be changed as follows:

On Sunday, if time and weather conditions permit, we intend to conduct a 3 race, Fleet Race Series, for the 8 boats placed 5th through 12th in the Round Robin stage of the Match Race Championship Event.

The series of 3 fleet races will be scored separately and will not count towards the Match Race Championship Scoring.

The fleet races will be sailed on a separate course with a separate race committee vessel located approximately 400 M from the Match Racing race committee vessel.

The 8 teams involved will sail the boats that they originally drew for sailing on Sunday.

The first warning signal for the Fleet Race Series will be scheduled for 10 am and no warning signal for the Fleet Race Series will be made after 1500.

Our intention to conduct the Fleet Race Series will be confirmed at the umpires debriefing meeting on Saturday after sailing and will be confirmed again at the Sunday morning Competitors meeting.

- To the extent they are applicable, the NOR and the SI for the CICSA Championship will be used for the Fleet Race Series.
- This document along with the Event NOR and SI are documents to be used for the conduct of the Fleet Race Series.
- These instructions maybe changed on the water in accordance with SI 2.2 by hails or signals from the Fleet Race, Race Committee Vessel
- Protests in the Fleet Races Series may be submitted as per RRS part 5.
- The Match Racing Appendix C of the RRS will not apply.

Courses, Marks, Starting, Finishing, Time Limit:

- The fleet races will be started using the signals and sounds as set out in RRS 26.
- Section 7 of the SI, Courses, 7.1 is changed to: Start - 1 - S/F - 1 - Finish, 7.2 is changed to: ALL MARKS SHALL BE ROUNDED TO PORT.
- Section 8 Marks / Starting and Finishing Line is changed as follows: 8.1 Mark 1 will be a yellow inflatable. Mark S/F will be a orange and white inflatable. Finish leaving the RC Vessel to PORT
- Section 12, Time Limit: In 12.1 Is changed to: Any boat finishing more than 15 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored DNF. Also, the Time Limit for the fleet races will be 60 minutes. The target time for the 3 fleet races will be 45 minutes each. The course length will be approximately 3 times longer than the Match Race courses.
